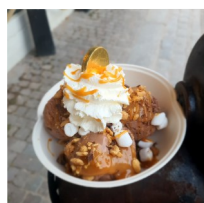

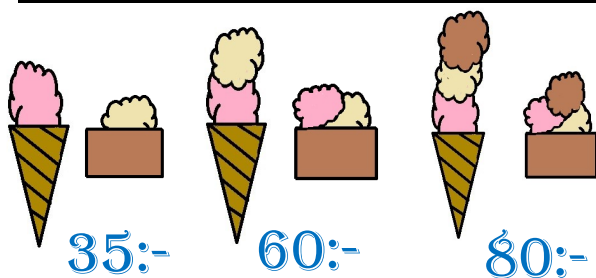

“REMEMBER THE ALAMO”

So why are we called AlaMOO? The Republic of Texas declared independence on March 2, 1836. Not wanting to be under the government of the United States; which had a treaty with Mexico over the Territory of Texas, the immigrants called themselves Texians. However, on March 6, 1836 Mexican soldiers under Mexican President General Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna reclaimed the Alamo Mission, near modern day San Antonio, Texas. The Mexicans left few survivors, who relayed the events of the battle and the strength of the Mexican Army. In retaliation the Texians took

up arms and fought against the Mexican Army at the Battle of San Jacinto on April 21, 1836 near Lynchburg Texas, defeating the Mexican Army. The battle cry of the Texians was “Remember the Alamo” in the act of leaving few survivors of the Mexican Army.
